- **Basic Guide to Health and Safety Committees**
Health and Safety committees must be formed to perform certain duties and functions.
- **Basic Guide to Health and Safety Duties of Workers**
All workers must report all health and safety incidents to their employer and the necessary health and safety parties.
- **Basic Guide to Health and Safety Representatives**
All employers who have 20 or more workers must appoint representatives for monitor health and safety conditions.

All health and safety inspectors must be allowed entrance to any workplace to obtain evidence. They are entitled to block off unsafe areas in the workplace.
